Background – Survey design process

- Questionnaire and the annual implementing regulation are revised annually.
 - Policy needs
 - Technology developments
 - Feasibility of collecting information
 - Constant quality improvements
 - Cooperation with the users and EU Member States (MS)
- Goal is to have harmonisation across EU MS
- The number of mandatory variables is limited to a maximum of 73 variables according to the EBS regulation
- Data are available at the end of the survey year

Scope

- **Enterprise size:** Enterprises with 10 or more employees or self-employed persons
Optional: enterprises with number of employees or self-employed persons between 0 and 9
- **Economic activity:** Enterprises classified in the following categories of NACE Rev. 2:
 - Section C – Manufacturing
 - Section D – Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply
 - Section E – Water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities
 - Section F – Construction
 - Section G – Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles
 - Section H – Transportation and storage
 - Section I – Accommodation and food service activities
 - Section J – Information and communication
 - Section L – Real estate activities
 - Section M – Professional, scientific and technical activities
 - Section N – Administrative and support service activities
 - Group 95.1 – Repair of computers and communication equipment

Recent developments

- **e-Commerce sales**
 - a new question on breaking down the web sales **value by type of products sold** has been introduced in 2025 ICT ENT survey → digitally ordered/delivered trade (exports) → voluntary

Recent developments

- **Monetary value of e-commerce sales**

- Figures on the monetary value of e-commerce sales were published in December 2023 in Eurostat's database
- Additional methodological clarification has been added in European metadata file

- **Web purchases**

- Questions on e-purchases has been prepared for countries that would like to collect the data (survey 2025)
- Purpose of producing the estimates of the digitally ordered trade (imports)
- 4 questions (on buying, value, geographical location of the seller, type of product purchased)

Recent developments

- **AI module**
 - A new answer option generative AI has been added (MQ 2025)
- **Cloud computing services**
 - A question on total cost of the cloud computing services purchased by the enterprise has been introduced (MQ 2025)
 - An answer option on AI solutions for generating text, images, video, audio content or codes (as a cloud computing service) has been introduced (MQ 2026) - still a draft

Recent developments

- **Extending the digitalisation measurement to other sectors**
 - Extending the digitalisation measurement to mining and quarrying and financial and insurance activities → voluntary
 - Financial and insurance sector: selected questions or modules already included in the ICT ENT survey will be used
